


The Service





The Briefing Stage

The briefing stage commences with a site measure and detailed assessment for existing properties or a land assessment for new builds. For both existing and new builds, we will assess site characteristics, surrounds and location context.

We also gather information about your personal style, family, project purpose (to live in, rent or sell), we look at how you use your home and what's important to you. From here we create a project mood board, taking inspiration from your current home, pieces of furniture you want to keep and aspirations for your future.

This stage focuses heavily on analysis and project scoping. Think lots of questions, inspiration pictures, cut outs from magazines, Pinterest boards, photos and site mapping.



The Concept Stage

We produce three concept designs for your project that gives you three unique ways you could use your space. These plans are quite conceptual with sketch drawings, mud maps and mood boards.

We understand that you're not going to love every idea we have - it's part of being a unique human! Three concepts allow us to really explore the opportunities for your project and emerge in the creative process.

We met again to present our three concepts and find out what you like, love and dislike about our proposals. At the end of this meeting there may be one clear winner or a combination of all designs that you like. We then proceed to the details stage!



The Details Stage

During this stage we take your feedback on the concept designs and produce a detailed design that includes plans, elevations, and sections of your space!

We design the built-in joinery, specify the fixtures and fittings, appliances and products as well as propose a colour and material palette for your project. Our work in this stage includes a lot of collaboration with you to bring your mood boards to life and really add in your own style and personality! In this final stage we prepare a detailed design document that includes all the drawings, specifications and finishes you need to build your dream home.

You can take these drawings to a draftsperson for building permit drawings if you need a permit for your project. (We will also help you find out if you need permits or not!)
